

IMPACT REPORT 2023



Father Gene's Help Center served a record 15,503 clients in 2023, an increase of 115% over 2022. In addition, we distributed 247,770 items, with 211,407 of those items distributed via client shopping appointments.

We made significant changes to our operations last year to respond to the need for clothing in the community. To accommodate more client shoppers, we completed a major renovation that doubled the shopping space for our clients. With the expansion, we offer clients a more enjoyable shopping experience with a greater selection of clothing and sizes.

In addition, we eliminated the need for clients to schedule an appointment to shop for clothing. Clients can shop for clothing when they need it and at a time that works with their schedules. We have made our services more accessible, which helps individuals and families in the community and makes the work of case managers easier. Case managers from local agencies provide critical transportation for their clients so they can come to FGHC to shop for clothing.

In response to the critical need for winter coats, we held our first Coat Day in November and distributed nearly 600 coats. We couldn't have done it without our team of volunteers and generous donors who donated coats that we were able to pass on to our clients.

As we expand our reach in the community, we ask for your continued support. Your clothing donations and monetary contributions allow us to provide life-changing services to people in need.
